Location Code List – Conditions of Use

The Location Code List (LCL) was updated in October 2016 and is available in Version 3.0. The LCL 3.0 will be used for the traffic information service from April 8, 2017 at 11 o'clock a.m. In the same way the Event Code List (*ECL*) 4.02 which is already in service, is subject to a continuous improvement cycle. Prior to ordering and receiving LCL 3.0, acceptance of the conditions of use for the LCL is required:

Conditions of Use for the Luxemburgish Location Code List, Version 3.0

The Grand-Duchy of Luxemburg represented by the National Road Administration (NRA) supplies the Luxemburgish Location Code List, Version 3.0 on the following conditions:

- 1. The user commits himself to make known the use of the Luxemburgish Location Code List Version 3.0 (LCL 3.0), to NRA. The "Proof of Use" slip is to be used for this purpose.
- 2. The user receives, at no charge, a not sub-licensable license to use both lists, for the given use. This right of use does not apply for updated versions of the lists. The disclosure of the Luxemburgish LCL 3.0 by the user to third parties is principally not admissible.

The disclosure to third parties is exceptionally admissible, if the user disseminates the LCL as component of a device or software or a digital map or its update, which is produced by him. In this case the user has to take appropriate measures to ensure, that a third party can't bring any liability or warranty claims towards the Grand-Duchy of Luxemburg, the Ministry of durable development and Infrastructures (MDDI) or the NRA because of correctness, completeness or content of the LCL. If there are any claims by third parties, the user shall indemnify the Grand-Duchy of Luxemburg, the MDDI and the NRA.

- 3. The MDDI and the NRA assume no liability for the completeness or accuracy of the LCL and/or its contents or for the presence of technical faults or mistakes in its content.
- 4. The MDDI and the NRA assume no liability for direct or indirect loss or damage, which could be connected with the use of the LCL.
- 5. With regard to points 4. and 5., liability of a third party is excluded to the same extent.
- 6. The period of validity of the LCL, Version 3.0/ ECL 4.01 cannot be stated at present; the MDDI and the NRA therefore accept no responsibility for the length of validity of the LCL/ ECL at issue.
